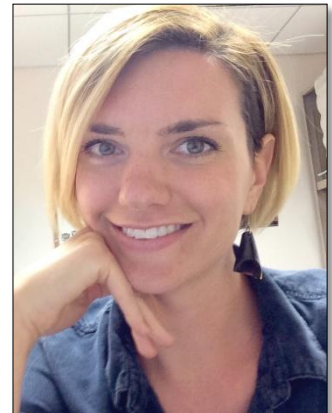

APPLICATION OF CRITICAL INFORMATION LITERACY DURING ONLINE RESEARCH
