

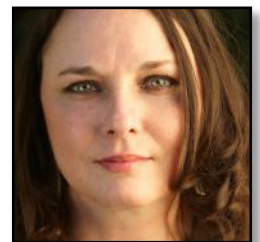

CONTROVERSY IN IMMIGRATION LAW

New policies have prioritized border security and strict enforcement of US immigration laws. However, a recent poll conducted by CNN shows that the public believes the government should prioritize developing a plan allowing undocumented immigrants to become legal residents. This presentation by attorney **Hadley Bajramovic** will begin with a brief overview of pathways leading to U.S. citizenship, main visa categories and common terms. Then we will discuss policies that led to 11.5 million undocumented immigrants in the United States. Q&A will follow the presentation.
